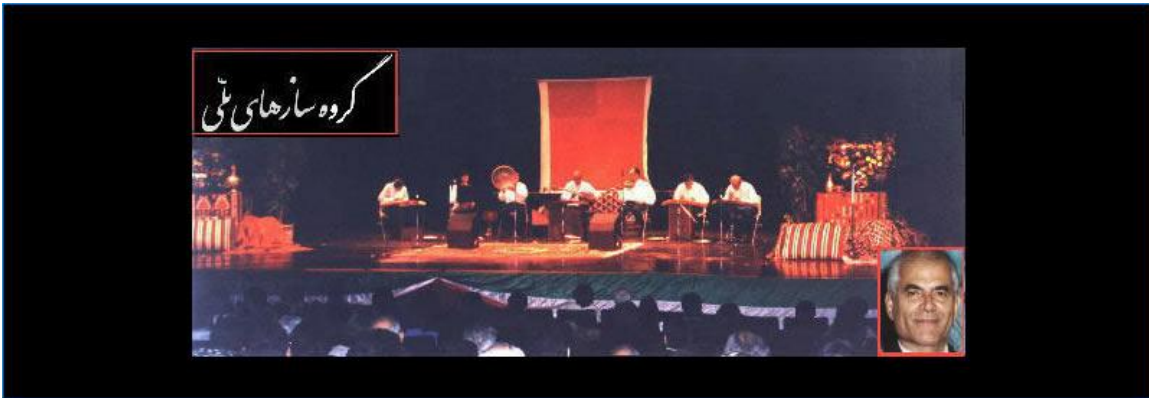


Biography- PNME members
